Glasgow's approach to commercial sexual exploitation

- Significant social problem in Glasgow which affects women, families and communities.
- Rejects the view of work or choice
- Survival behaviour
- The only free choice is that of the purchaser, who decides when, where and how he will buy sex
- Caused by, and perpetuates, gender inequality
- Violence against women

Glasgow's services


- **Drop in service** evening for women involved in street prostitution, 2 days per week for women involved in indoor prostitution
- Outreach
- Case management
- Joint work to address boyfriends/pimps
- Prostitution link workers in Addiction teams
- Alternative to custody for women involved in the Criminal Justice system
- Young women's project supports vulnerable girls and young women
- Front line services network includes homelessness orgs, women's sector, addiction staff, police liaison team
- Open roads support service for men

Impact on women

- Physical harm
- Emotional and psychological harm
- Stigma and shame
- Isolated and scared
- Rejected by family/community
- Vulnerable to targeting/blackmail
- Post traumatic stress


- Awareness of sexual exploitation?

- 50 unknown


